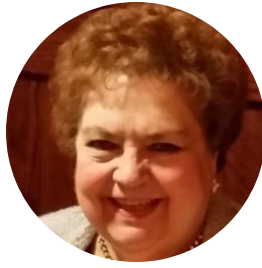

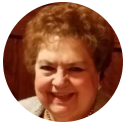
Evelyn Smith Walkowz, October 10, 1941 – April 27, 2016

The family would like to thank all the caregivers; hospital staff; DaVita staff; and Hospice staff for their efforts, care, and dedication.

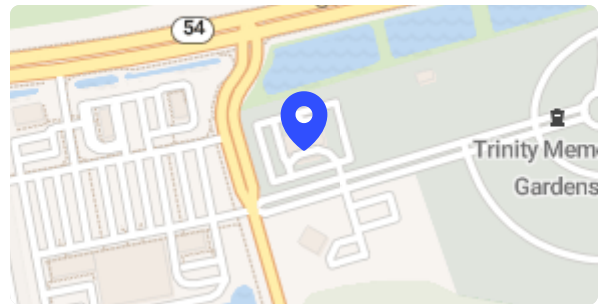
