A Funeral Mass will be held at St. Thomas Aquinas Catholic Church on Monday, December 10th, at 10:30.

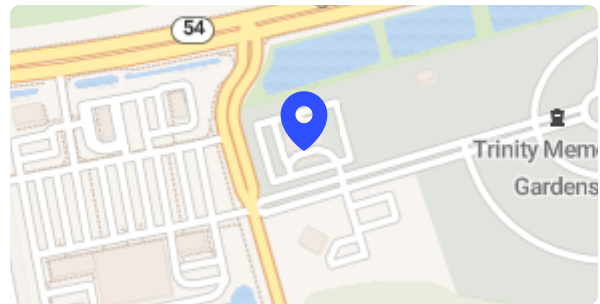
