It is with deep sorrow and much love that we mourn the untimely passing of Amelita (Amy) Marquez, age 64, of Tampa on January 20, 2021. She was born in the Philippines in 1956 to Francisco and Socorro Ramos (Macion). She graduated from Chinese General Hospital College of Nursing in 1978 with a Nursing degree. She courageously immigrated to the United States in 1979. She worked tirelessly as a nurse for over 40 years giving her unselfish love, kindness, generosity and support to countless patients and their families. She was a devout Catholic, attended mass daily, traveled to Haiti to perform missionary work, organized weekly mass at a nursing home, and was known for always putting others before herself. 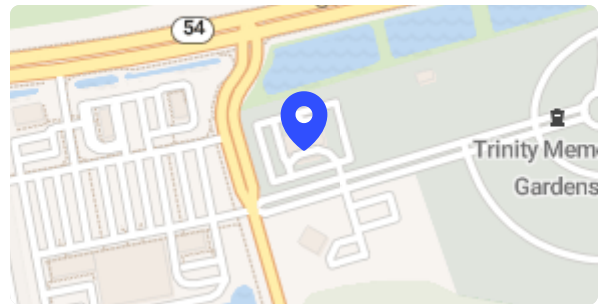

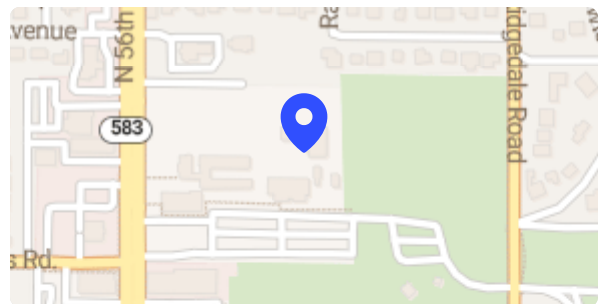

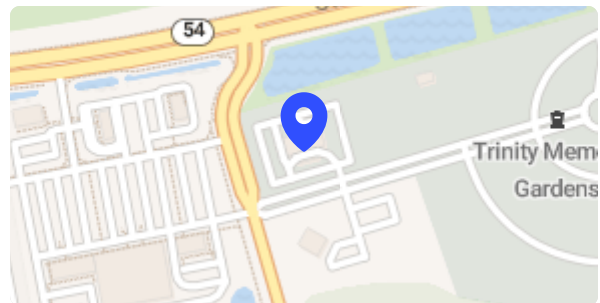
