David Charles Frook, 82, of Odessa, FL, died peacefully at his home on January 28, 2021.

David was born January 18, 1939 in Fond du Lac, WI to Walter and Alice (Orth) Frook.

He graduated from Goodrich Senior High School, Fond du Lac, WI in 1957 and went on to attend the University of Wisconsin - Oshkosh, studying History and English.

David married his high school sweetheart, Joyita "Joy" Tagliapietra, in Fond du Lac in 1960. He served 6 years with the Wisconsin National Guard (32nd Infantry Division) during the early years of his lifelong career in the sales and marketing industry.

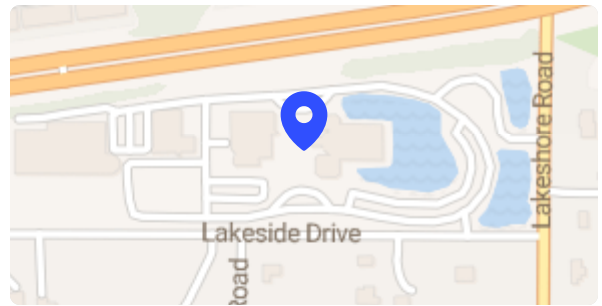
