Ronald Jacob Roth was born in White Plains, New York on August 25, 1946 to William Roth and Velma Verost.

At the age of ten, he cleaned bar stools at a soda fountain and was paid in milkshakes, but he was quickly removed of his duties when it was discovered that he was taking too many pay advances.

The stint at the soda fountain taught him the importance of work ethic and properly investing money. Ron went on to become a very successful entrepreneur whose business acumen often took him to Asia and Europe, where he made lifelong friendships with many people around the world.

He was a member of the Knights of Columbus at St. Timothy's Catholic Church in Lutz, FL. He was proud to have sung in L'Église de la Madeleine in Paris with St. Timothy's Catholic Church Choir in 2011.
