Norma's presence on earth will be greatly missed but she is forever in our hearts. Please think of her whenever you see a butterfly, a hummingbird, or a beautiful flower.



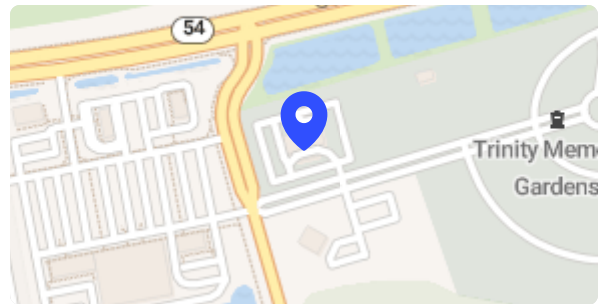

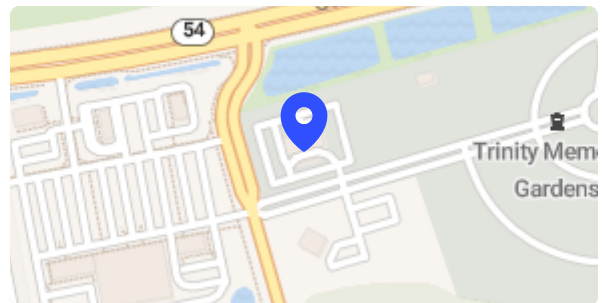
