John R. Silvestri of Trinity, Florida passed away on Thursday, July 28th, 2022 at the age of 84. He was born in the Bronx, NY on October 20, 1937, the son of John and Clorinda (DeSanto) Silvestri.

John graduated from DeWitt Clinton High School, Bronx, NY. He served honorably in the United States Air Force and the Air National Guard. John received his BA from Pace University and his MBA from Adelphi University. John retired from business as an Information Systems manager working with CitiBank, JPMorgan Chase and as a consultant.

On June 20th, 1964, John married Frances (Tina) Genovese in New Hyde Park, NY. They lived in Port Washington, NY where they raised their family, until 2002 when they relocated to Florida. John is survived by his wife Tina who lives in Trinity, Florida; daughter Lisa Marie Silvestri who lives in Frankfurt, Germany; and son John P. Silvestri and wife Beth Ann (Vasile) Silvestri and their sons John Thomas and Benjamin Matthew, who live in Tuckahoe, NY. John is predeceased by his sister, Elena Lombardi and brother, Benedict Silvestri.

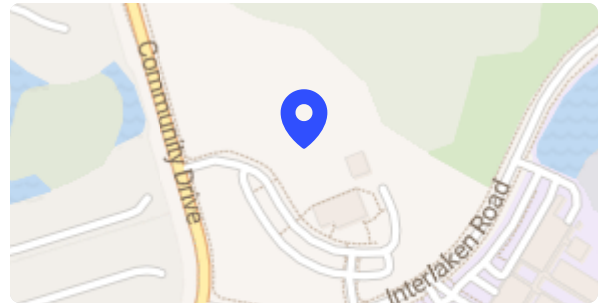
