Pushpa Rohit Vyas, 69, passed away peacefully on January 17, 2024 with her family by her side.

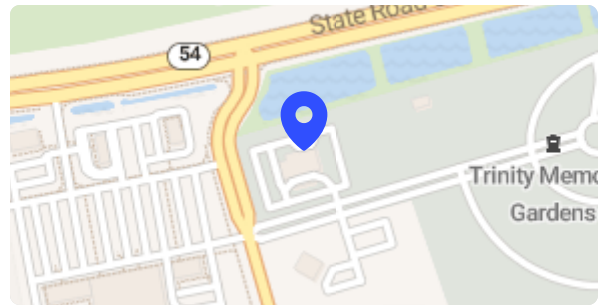
