Beverly will be profoundly missed by her family, church community, and many friends. Her legacy of love, faith, and strength will continue to inspire all who had the privilege of knowing her.






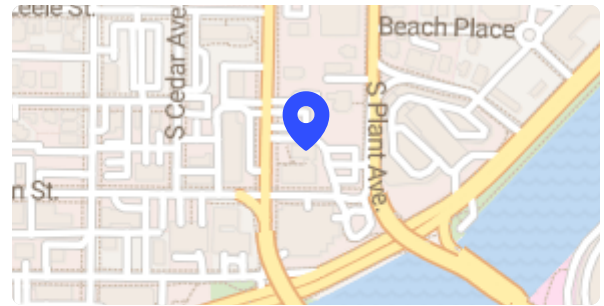
