Barbara Paradiso, 68 of Tampa, Florida passed away on January 3, 2025. She was born in Manhattan, New York on May 9, 1956. Her family relocated and she was raised in the Bulls Head section of Staten Island, New York. She attended and graduated from Port Richmond Highschool and Staten Island Community College where she earned her degree in Early Childhood Education. Barbara and her husband moved their family to Tampa, Florida where they raised their two children.

Barbara was a beloved wife, mother, grandmother, and friend who meant so much to many over the years. Her love for children and education led her to become a certified home daycare provider for over 10 years. 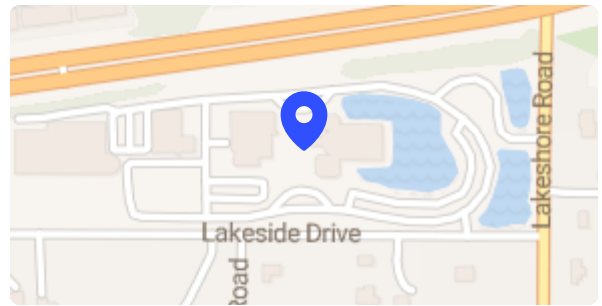
