The family wishes to extend their gratitude to friends and family.

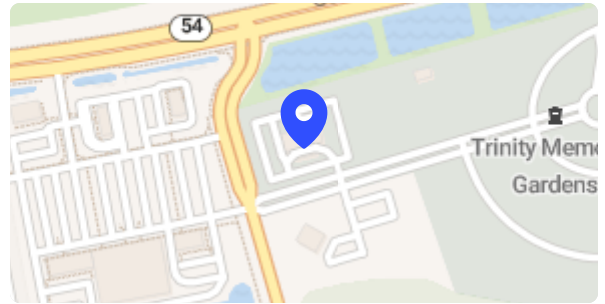

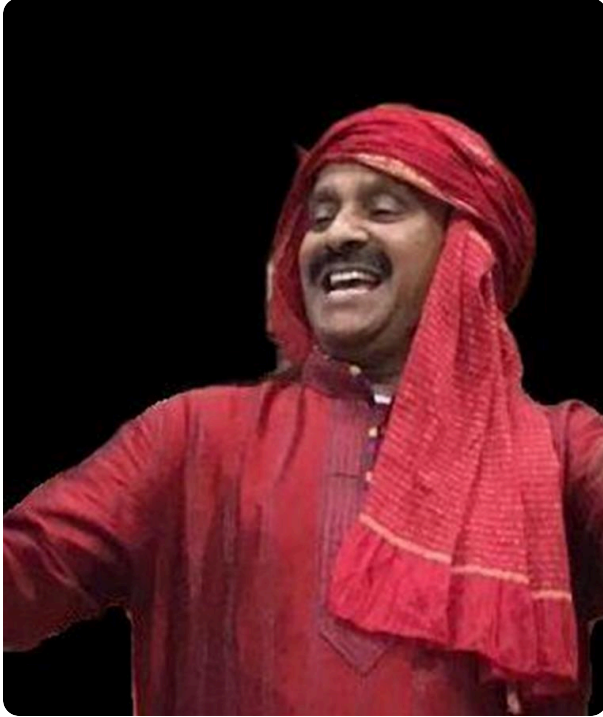
