Kathy will be remembered for her love, her strength, her creativity, and the many ways she made others feel seen, safe, and at home. She will remain forever in our hearts.



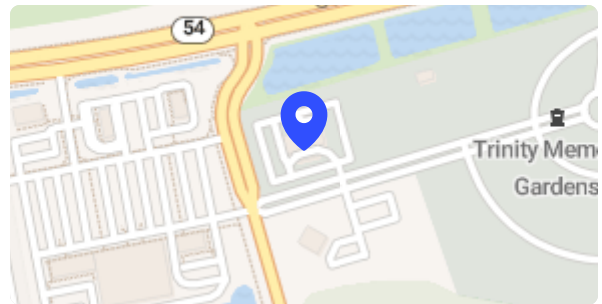
