Richard Allen Harrison passed away peacefully on April 13, 2026, at the age of 87. He was born on August 11, 1938, in San Luis Obispo, CA.

Richard proudly served in the United States Air Force for 26 years, concluding his career as maintenance superintendent. His career took him around the world with assignments in Newfoundland, Florida, Texas, Thailand, Germany, Michigan's Upper Peninsula, the Philippines, Georgia and New Mexico.

While stationed at MacDill Air Force Base in Tampa, Richard met the love of his life, Carol, and they married in 1961 at the Christ the King Catholic Church. The couple recently celebrated their 65th wedding anniversary, a testament to their lifelong devotion and partnership. After retirement from the military in 1983, Richard and Carol returned to Tampa where he pursued his 2nd career. 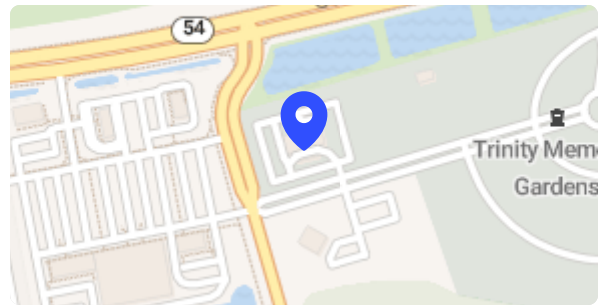

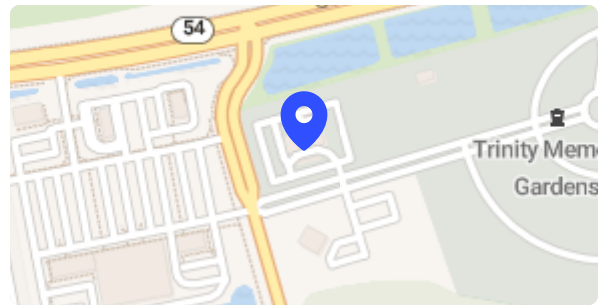

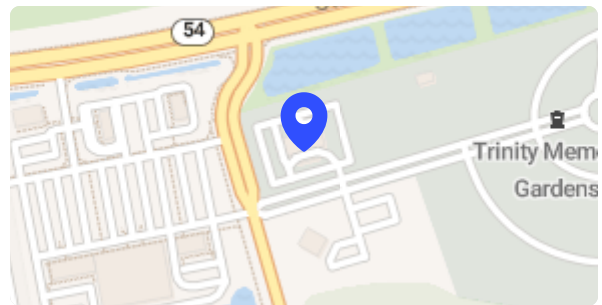
